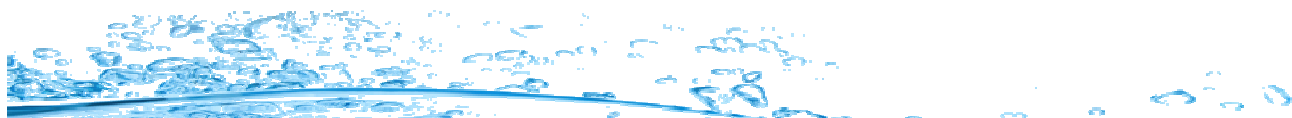

# WaSaFin Program

**It is a CSR finance to improve health status, minimize medical expenses and increase productivity that would improve overall life quality of the borrowers' family members.**

**In collaboration and services agreement with Water.Org for technical assistance and advisory services**

**Started Sep-2014 on Pilot and rolled out in January 2016**

**Existing borrower can avail a loan amounting 4k to 20k either for water or sanitary toilet one at a time**

**Loan is for one year with add-on Charges 15% annually**

**24, 566 loans with Php 306.7 million released**

**99.53% recovery rate**





# WaSaFin Program

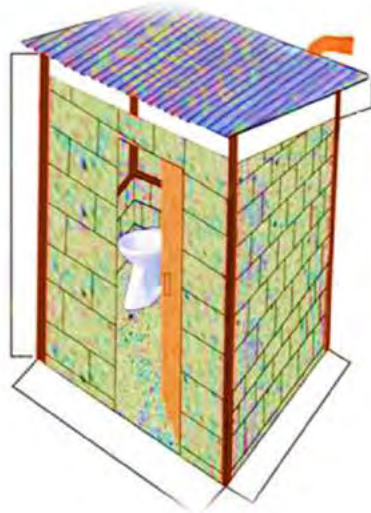
**Provide primary health care education and consultancy for installation of sanitary toilet and water connection**

**Planned to include at least 200,000 households in 2 years**

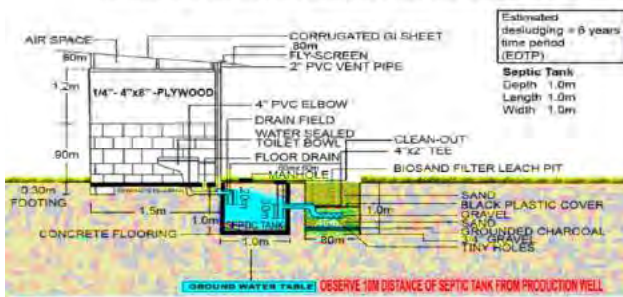

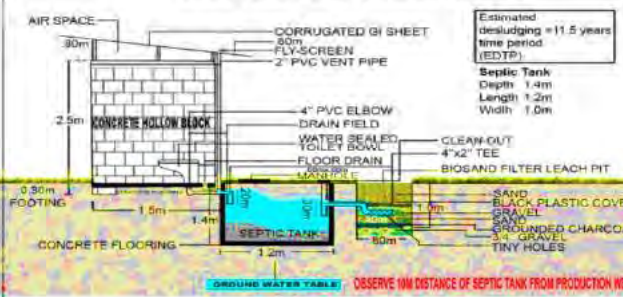
Half-concrete, half-plywood toilet with single chamber septic tank

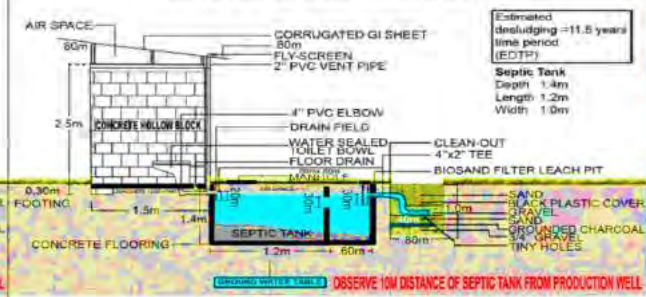
Concrete toilet with single chamber septic tank

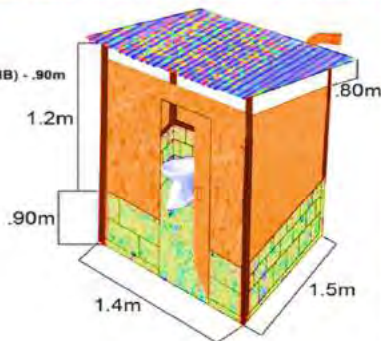

Concrete toilet with double chamber septic tank



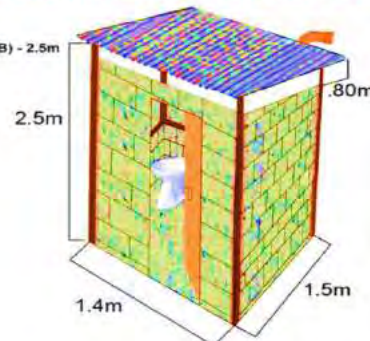
