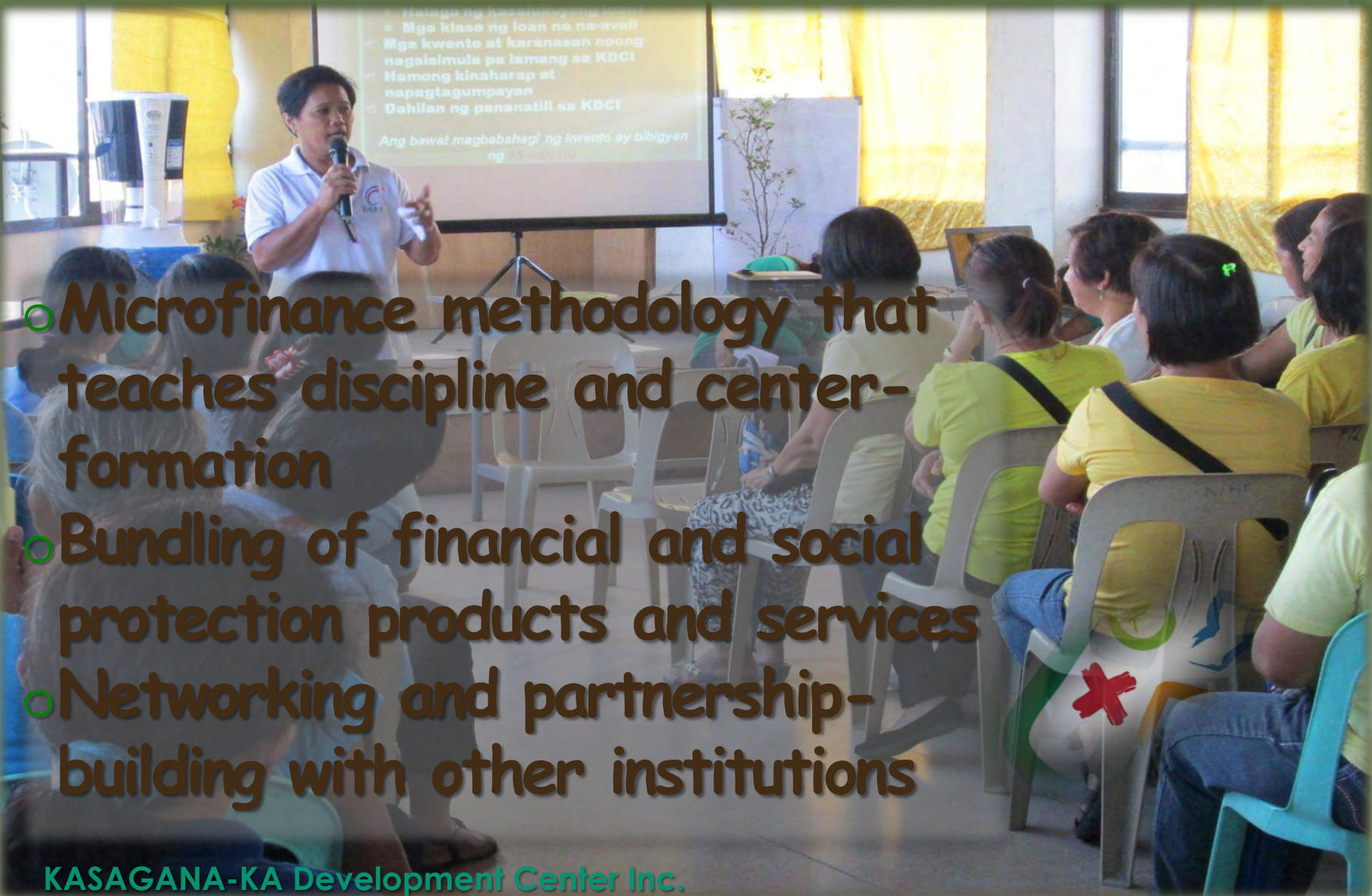


# KDCI's Mission

KDCI is a support institution that gives hope, guidance and opportunity to raise standards of living and develop the character of poor Filipino women, their families and communities in the urban areas.

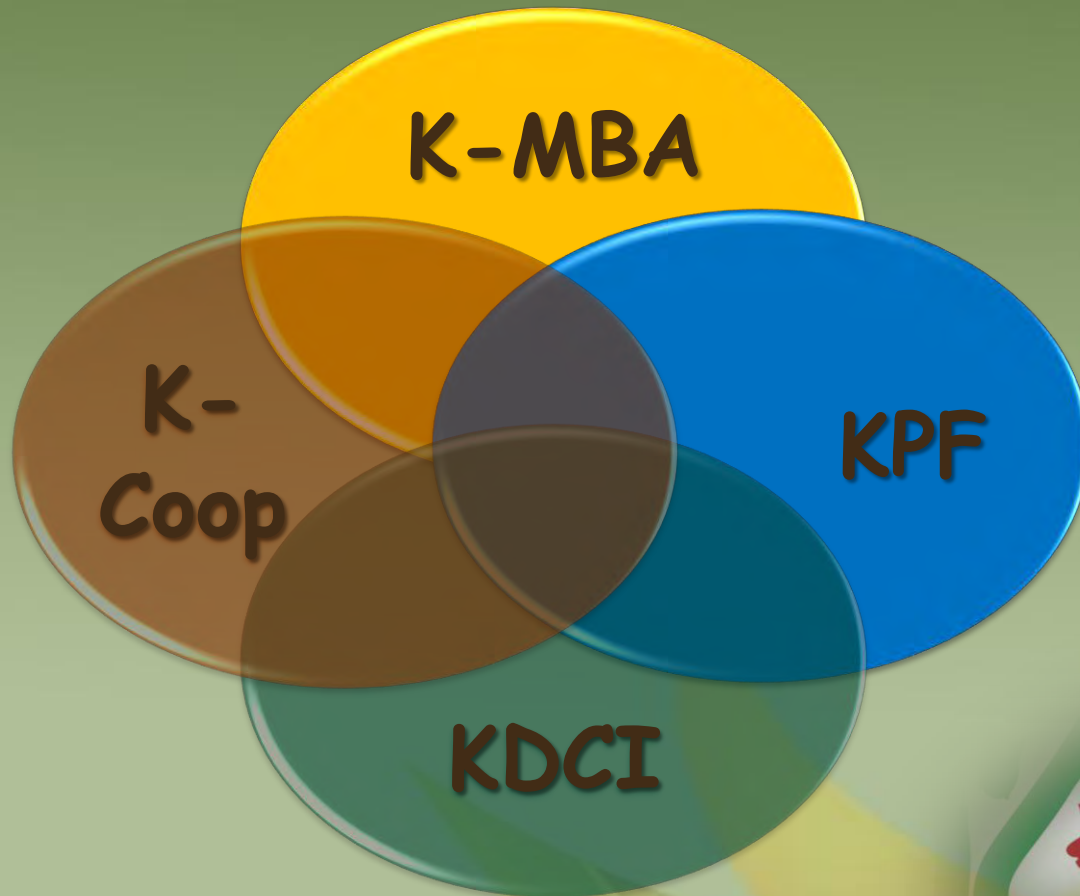

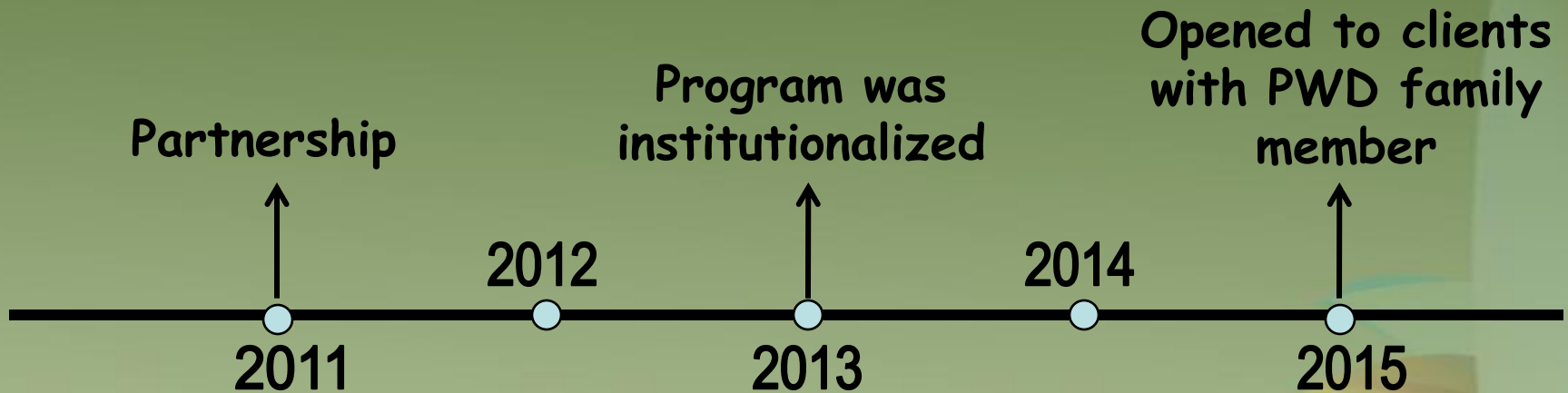
